The polls will be open from **7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 4, 2026**, at all voting places in Woodson County.

4-H Community Building

For voters residing in Center, Liberty, North, Piqua, Neosho Falls, and Perry Townships.

Toronto Township Community Building

200 S. Broad St. Toronto, KS 66777

For voters residing in Toronto City and Toronto Township.

Ambulance Building

114 N. Main St., Yates Center, KS 66783

For voters residing in First Ward and Second Ward of the City of Yates Center.

The polls will open at **7:00 o'clock a.m.** and close at **7:00 o'clock p.m.** on **August 4, 2026**

Advance Voting

Advance voting in person will begin as provided by law. Early voting will begin **Wednesday, July 15th, 2026** in the Woodson County Clerk's office, 105 W Rutledge St, Yates Center, KS 66783. Polls will be open at 8:00 a.m. and close at 4:45 p.m. Early voting will close at 12:00 p.m. on **August 3rd, 2026**.

Applications for advance voting ballots may be obtained from the Woodson County Election Office. Completed applications must be submitted in accordance with Kansas election laws.

Voter Registration

Tuesday, July 14th, 2026, is the last day to register to vote or update voter registration information in order to be eligible to vote in the August 4th, 2026, Primary Election.

A citizen of the United States who is 18 years of age or older, or will have attained the age of 18 years at the next election, must register before he or she can vote. Registration is open until the close of business on the 21st day before the election

Voters must bring Valid ID with them to vote.

When a voter has been registered according to law, the voter shall remain registered until the voter changes name by marriage, divorce or other legal proceedings or changes residence. The voter may reregister in person, by mail or other delivery when registration is open or the voter may reregister on election day.
