

"NOTICE OF PLACES AND DATES OF REGISTRATION"

In compliance with the provisions of K.S.A 25-2310, notice is hereby given that the books for registration of voters will be open at the following places during regular business hours: The Office of the County Clerk, Courthouse, Woodson.

Persons who apply for services at voter registration agencies may register at the following places during regular business hours: the Office of the County Clerk, Courthouse, Woodson, or online www.woodsoncounty.net; any city clerk's office, Piqua Rural Water Office, Department of Motor Vehicles, US Mail (request Kansas Voter Registration Application by mail or telephone); also available in Online registration-follow thru as directed.

Beginning on the 7th day of July, 2022, additional hours of registration will be provided at the following places: Woodson County Clerk's Office and any City Clerk's Office in Woodson County.


At 5:00 p.m. on the 12th day of July, 2022, the books for registration of voters will close and will remain closed until the 3rd day of August, 2022.

A citizen of the United States who is 18 years of age or older, or will have attained the age of 18 years at the next election must register before he or she can vote. Registration is open until the close of business on the 21st day before the election.

When a voter has been registered according to law, the voter shall remain registered until the voter changes name by marriage, divorce or other legal proceeding or changes residence. The Voter may reregister in person, by mail or other delivery when registration is open or the voter may reregister on election day.

Application forms shall be provided by the county election officer or the Secretary of State upon request. The application shall be signed by the applicant under penalty of perjury.
