

The Woodson County Treasurer's Office is very aware of how COVID-19 could impact our office and how it will affect our ability to continue to serve the public in a timely and effective manner.

The Courthouse will have restricted access as of Monday March 23, 2020. In the Treasurer's Office services will be limited since the State of Kansas Motor Vehicle and Driver's License operations will be closed for 2 weeks. We will not be performing Driver's License transactions during this period. ALL transactions will be limited to phone, online or mail in transactions.

We would like to remind everyone that vehicle tags may be renewed online or mailed in, we can take payment over the phone when the insurance for the vehicle is provided. Property tax payments can be mailed in, paid online or paid over the phone. We will take phone calls and make arrangements to perform transactions on a limited basis. Some transactions will be difficult to perform with our limited resources.

Driver's License renewals for persons under the age of 50 who have visited an Eye Doctor within the last year may be performed online also.

All late vehicle renewals or late property tax payments can be paid by calling our office at 620-625-8605 Extension 4 for a quote and mailing in payment or paying over the phone with a credit card. A fee does apply for online and phone payments.

For Title Transactions, the customer listed on the back of the title will need to call the Treasurer's Office to arrange drop-off of documents or documents need to be mailed to the office. Employees will work up the transaction and call the customer to let them know how much it will cost. If the customer wants to come to the Courthouse they need to call the Treasurer's Office and they will be instructed on the procedure. All customers will have to wait outside of the Courthouse while transactions are performed.
