

The Board of Woodson County Commissioners met in a regular business session on September 29th, 2020 at 8:30 a.m. with Chairman Forsyth, Vice Chairman Yoho, Member Barnett, and County Clerk Porter.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by Forsyth, Yoho, and Porter.

Yoho moved to approve the agenda as amended. Barnett seconded the motion with Forsyth making it unanimous.

Yoho moved to approve the September 22<sup>nd</sup> minutes. Barnett seconded the motion with Forsyth making it unanimous.

Treasurer Zimmerman discussed with the Board the Woodson County Coronavirus Relief Fund, Small Business Assistance Grant Program. Friends for Life will be using the hand sanitizer and masks provided by the grant. Discussion was held regarding a local business wanting to do a job fair. Suggestions from the Board members using part of grant money for advertisement. No action was taken.

Yoho made the motion to have Emergency Preparedness Director Stukey sign the Coronavirus Relief Fund for the amount of \$17,120.00. Barnett seconded the motion with Forsyth making it unanimous.

Public Works Director Onnen presented the Road and Bridge weekly reports. Onnen explained the Courthouse boiler inspection was passed. Onnen also presented Heritage Hills work orders.

Barnett made the motion to accept the Sheriff's wage sheet on full-time Deputy Christopher Bowman. Yoho seconded the motion with Forsyth making it unanimous. The Board discussed with Sheriff Campbell there needs to be a contract set up with new Law Enforcement Officers/Deputies and Dispatchers that if sent to academy and training, those employees need to stay with the County for at least two years, or repayment to County.

Yoho made the motion for the Woodson County Chamber of Commerce to use the band stand on the courthouse lawn for the Fall Festival. Barnett seconded the motion with Forsyth making it unanimous.

Yoho made the motion to have the EMT call numbers 202-Charyl Stewart, 215- Tom Stewart be retired from service, starting on October 1, 2020. Barnett seconded the motion with Forsyth making it unanimous.


Yoho made the motion to accept the wage sheet for part-time EMT employee Stitt. Barnett seconded the motion with Forsyth making it unanimous.
