Sheriff Jeff McCullough presented his weekly reports.


Jarrod McVey, Noxious Weed, Solid Waste & Maintenance Supervisor discussed bids for the roof repair on the Courthouse.

Faulkner made the motion to adjourn at 10:10 a.m. Clark seconded it.




