

The Board of Woodson County Commissioners met in a regular business session on June 9th, 2020 at 8:30 a.m. with Chairman Forsyth, Vice Chairman Yoho, Member Barnett, County Attorney Schlotterbeck and County Clerk Porter.

Yoho seconded the motion with Forsyth making it unanimous.






