Barnett moved to approve the July 16th, 2019 minutes as printed. Forsyth second the motion with Yoho making it unanimous.


County Attorney Schlotterbeck reported on a letter from Bideau law Office regarding the Quinn/Weber fence viewing.




Forsyth made the motion to approve paying the vouchers for the amount of \$128,526.25. Barnett second the motion with Yoho making it unanimous.
