

The Board of Woodson County Commissioners met in a regular business session on October 11th, 2022 with Chairman Justin Clark, Vice-Chairman Wayne Faulkner, Member Monty Barnett, County Attorney Zelda Schlotterbeck and County Clerk Tesla Bayles.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Barnett made the motion to approve the agenda. Faulkner seconded it, with Clark making it unanimous.

Barnett made the motion to approve the minutes from October 4th, 2022. Faulkner seconded it, with Clark making it unanimous.

Faulkner moved to recess into executive session for Attorney Client privileges to discuss legal liability for 15 minutes with the Commissioners and the County Attorney starting at 8:36 a.m. and reconvene at 8:51 a.m. in the Commissioners Meeting Room. Barnett seconded it, with Clark making it unanimous.

Road and Bridge Supervisor Timothy Dimick gave an update on bridge at 165th and Fox that is being redone. Dimick requested to purchase a new computer for the road and bridge office. Dimick presented quotes from Advantage Computers. Faulkner made the motion to allow the Road and Bridge Office to purchase a computer for \$1,890.00 from Advantage Computers. Barnett seconded it, with Clark making it unanimous.

Sheriff Jeff McCullough informed the board he has had an issue with the coroner. McCullough asked for the board to replace the coroner. The board was unsure of their authority to replace a coroner.

Noxious Weed, Solid waste and Maintenance Supervisor Jarrod McVey came to the board. KJ Electrical is working on tying together the lightning system.

Barnett made the motion to approve the wage increase for end of probation. Clark seconded it, with Faulkner making it unanimous. McVey is going to purchase LED Christmas lights to replace the old ones.

Took public comment from John Adkins.


Took a 5-minute break.



Clark declared there will be not meeting October 18th, 2022 due to a Kansas Association of Counties Meeting.
