

The Board of Woodson County Commissioners met in a regular business session on November 12th, 2019 at 8:30 a.m. with Chairman Yoho, Vice Chairman Forsyth, County Attorney Schlotterbeck, and County Clerk Porter.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by Yoho, Forsyth, Schlotterbeck and Porter.

Forsyth moved to approve the agenda as amended. Yoho second the motion.

Forsyth moved to approve the November 5th, 2019 minutes as printed. Yoho second the motion.


Public Works Administrator Onnen presented weekly reports. Road and Bridge Department continues to haul rock.


Rural Fire Chief Nick Barney explained to the Board the Rescue Unit is having problems and there is a need to explore options in looking at a newer unit. Barney also addressed he will need to purchase a tank/pump. The Board recommended to Chief Barney to check with EMS Director Tom Stewart regarding used units that can be purchased and used as Rescue Units.

Stephanie Bedell presented to the Board a resolution adopting the proposed amendment from the Woodson County joint planning commission related to the abatement of nuisances. It was recommended the Board will address the resolution when all Board members will be present.

Forsyth made the motion to pay the vouchers in the amount of \$124,778.61. Yoho second the motion.
