David Williams, Salesman for Emporia Kenworth presented specs on a 2011 truck. No action was taken.

The Board recessed for a break at 9:11.


The Board came back into session at 9:21 with all members present.




Barnett made the motion to pay the vouchers in the amount of \$51,199.48. Forsyth second the motion with Yoho making it unanimous.
