

RESOLUTION # 20-10

A resolution regarding the use of face masks

WHEREAS the Governor of Kansas issued Executive Order No. 20-52 mandating the use of face masks in all public areas; and,

WHEREAS Kansas law authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to issue orders relating to public health that include provisions that are less stringent than the provisions of an executive order effective statewide issued by the Governor; and,

WHEREAS there is only one active COVID case in Woodson County, Kansas,

WHEREAS the board has consulted with the local health officer and following such consultation concerning the implementation of the use of face masks, as required by executive order No. 20-52, the board has determined that the mandatory use of face masks in public is not necessary to protect the public health and safety of the county; but instead strongly recommend wearing face masks or other face coverings in public areas that social distancing cannot be obtained and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Woodson County, Kansas, determines that the mandatory use of face masks in public is not required, but strongly recommended in Woodson County, Kansas. Nothing herein shall restrict any business, municipality or organization from requiring its patrons or citizens to wear a mask or other face covering.




