A Resolution to amending Woodson County Resolution 07-06 and 15-07

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners determined that the employees of Woodson County, Kansas shall be eligible for a bonus in salary after accruing six (6) years of service or more.

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners clarified that the qualifying years of service must be continuous.

Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners specifies that part time and temporary employees, as defined by the Woodson County Employee Handbook, are not eligible for the longevity bonus.

Now Therefore, the Board of County Commissioners of Woodson County resolves as follows:

LONGEVITY BONUS POLICY FOR PART-TIME EMPLOYEES

Every regular part-time employee of Woodson County, Kansas, as defined by the Woodson County Handbook, who has accrued at least six (6) continuous years of service as an employee of Woodson County shall be eligible for a bonus in salary. Said bonus shall be a Fifty dollar base bonus (\$50.00) for the sixth year of employment. For each additional consecutive year of employment following the sixth year, each employee so qualifying shall be eligible for an additional Ten dollars (\$10.00) for each additional consecutive year of employment added to the initial Fifty dollar (\$50.00) base bonus designated in the following chart:

LONGEVITY BONUS POLICY FOR FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES AND ELECTED OFFICIALS


Every permanent full-time employee and elected official, as defined by the Woodson County Handbook, of Woodson County, Kansas who has accrued at least six (6) continuous years of service as an employee of Woodson County shall be eligible for a bonus in salary. Said bonus shall be a three-hundred dollar base bonus (\$300.00) for the sixth year of employment. For each additional consecutive year of employment following the sixth year, each employee so qualifying shall be eligible for an additional sixty dollars (\$60.00) for each additional consecutive year of employment added to the initial three-hundred dollar (\$300.00) base bonus designated in the following chart:


