

RESOLUTION NO. 01-07

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS, TO CONSTRUCT A PUBLIC BUILDING AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OR NOTES OF THE COUNTY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$200,000 TO PAY THE COSTS THEREOF (AMBULANCE FACILITY).

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 19-15,114 to 19-15,118, inclusive, as amended (the "Act"), authorizes the Board of County Commissioners of Woodson County, Kansas (the "County"), to erect or construct, acquire and improve public buildings and to issue general obligation bonds of the County for such purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County has determined that it is necessary to construct a facility to house ambulances in the County at an estimated cost of \$200,000 (the "Public Building Project"); and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable to pay the costs of the Public Building Project through the issuance of general obligation bonds or notes of the County, and it is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners to use funds available to the Woodson County ambulance department to pay the principal of and interest on such notes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS:

Section 1. In accordance with the Act, the Board of County Commissioners of the County hereby finds and declares the necessity for and authorizes the Public Building Project.

Section 2. For the purpose of providing funds to pay the cost of the Public Building Project, the County authorizes the issuance of its general obligation bonds or notes in an aggregate amount of \$200,000 pursuant to the Act. This resolution shall constitute a declaration of official intent pursuant to U.S. Treasury Regulation, §1.150-2.

Section 3. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption by the Board of County Commissioners.
