**RESOLUTION NO. 02-02**

**A RESOLUTION ASSURING THE KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE & HOUSING THAT FUNDS WILL BE CONTINUALLY PROVIDED FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF IMPROVEMENTS TO THE SENIOR CITIZEN CENTER TO BE FINANCED WITH COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS**

**WHEREAS, Woodson County** is applying for Small Cities Community Development Block Grant funds under the Community Improvement Category, as administered by the Kansas Department of Commerce & Housing; and,

**WHEREAS, Woodson County** wishes to utilize this funding for the purpose of constructing improvements to the County's senior citizen center, as described in the Community Development Block Grant application submitted to the Kansas Department of Commerce & Housing; and,


**WHEREAS, Woodson County** has determined that the annual operation and maintenance costs of the senior citizens center improvements are anticipated to be approximately \$3,000; and,


**WHEREAS,** The annual maintenance budget has been determined to be adequate to fund the operation and maintenance of the senior citizen center,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:** The Governing Body of Woodson County, Kansas, hereby assures the Kansas Department of Commerce & Housing that sufficient funds will be provided for the continued operation and maintenance of the above described senior citizen center; that these operation and maintenance costs will be reviewed annually; and that the maintenance budget will be adjusted, when necessary, to reflect and cover any increase in costs.
