

Woodson County Resolution 10-D8

A Resolution Ordering the County Counselor to Institute an Action for **Tax Foreclosure**

WHEREAS, numerous parcels of real estate have been sold and bid in by the County at delinquent tax sales since September, 1990 and have remained unredeemed on the 1st day of September of the 3rd year after such sale; and,

WHEREAS, the legislature has passed laws providing for the foreclosure of tax liens and the sale of real estate in order to collect delinquent taxes:


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the duly elected Board of County Commissioners of Woodson County, Kansas that a judicial foreclosure and sale of real estate tax liens be held. The County Attorney of Woodson County is hereby ordered to prepare the necessary pleadings to initiate and prosecute a tax foreclosure action in accord with the provisions of K.S.A. 79-2801 et.seq.






