

RESOLUTION # 96-06

**A RESOLUTION** reconfirming support for the qualifying regional strategic plan and requesting that the Secretary of Commerce & Housing reapprove the County of Woodson as a Kansas Enterprise Zone designated non-metropolitan region and rescinding Resolution # 1993-06.

**WHEREAS**, A regional strategic plan, required by K.S.A. 74-50,116(c)(2), has been reviewed and updated; and

**WHEREAS**, The updated plan has been adopted by the County Commission of the County of Woodson on OCTOBER 1, 1996; and

**WHEREAS**, Regional business incentive of waiver of fees for Building Permits will be offered to all qualified businesses in the County; and

**WHEREAS**, Additional county-wide business incentives of consideration of Industrial Revenue Bond financing, and property tax abatement, for all qualified businesses in the County requesting such consideration;

**WHEREAS**, All qualified businesses in the County will be notified of the availability of the State and regional incentives indicated above by a news release in the official county newspaper, posting at City Halls, and in the County Clerk's Office in the County Courthouse; and




**NOW, THEREFORE,**




