## **RESOLUTION NO 19-04**

## A RESOLUTION IMPOSING STRICTER REQUIREMENTS FOR BARBED WIRE FENCES

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 29-105 provides that the Boards of County Commissioners may, by resolution, establish stricter requirements for a legal barbed wire fence, on all new fences.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Woodson County, Kansas find that the minimum requirements for a legal barbed wire fence as defined in K.S.A. 29-105(a) is insufficient to prevent cattle from escape.

## THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF WOODSON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS,

- 1. In addition to the requirements contained in K.S.A. 29-105(a) all legal barbed wire fences shall have;
  - a. four strands of smooth, galvanized wires, twisted together with two or four sharp barbs, on all perimeter fences.
  - b. five strands of barbed wire stretched between posts, on division fences between different land owners.
  - c. and at least one post spaced every 13 1/2 feet.
- 2. This resolution is effective upon publication in the official Woodson County Newspaper.
