

RESOLUTION NO 19-05

**AMENDING RESOLUTION NO 19-04
A RESOLUTION IMPOSING STRICTER REQUIREMENTS FOR BARBED WIRE
FENCES**

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 29-105 provides that the Boards of County Commissioners may, by resolution, establish stricter requirements for a legal barbed wire fence for all newly constructed fences.

WHEREAS, Woodson County Resolution No. 19-04 needs to be amended.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Woodson County, Kansas find that the minimum requirements for a legal barbed wire fence as defined in K.S.A. 29-105(a) is insufficient to prevent cattle from escape.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF WOODSON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS,


1. In addition to the requirements contained in K.S.A. 29-105(a) all legal barbed wire fences that are on the perimeter shall have;
 - a. four strands of smooth, galvanized wires, twisted together with two or four sharp barbs, and
 - b. at least one post spaced every 16 1/2 feet.
2. In addition to the requirements contained in K.S.A. 29-105(a) all legal barbed wire fences that are on division fences between different land owners shall have;
 - a. five strands of barbed wire stretched between posts, and
 - b. at least one post spaced every 16 1/2 feet.
3. This resolution is effective upon publication in the official Woodson County Newspaper.

Passed and adopted in regular session this 7th day of May 2019.


