Woodson County Resolution No. 22-13

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE SALARY AND COMPENSATION OF ELECTION BOARD WORKERS OF WOODSON COUNTY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS that by a majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners sitting in regular session on the 14th day of June 2022 adopt the following provision concerning compensation and salary of Election Board Workers of Woodson County, Kansas, to-wit:

- 1. Judges of election where voting machines are used shall receive for their services 10 dollars per hour.
- 2. Clerks of election where voting machines are used shall receive for their services 9 dollars per hour.
- 3. In addition to other compensation authorized under subsections (1) and (2), the supervising judge shall receive the sum of .58 cents per mile necessarily traveled in the course of such service.
- 4. Any judge or clerk of an election may, upon written consent, decline to accept compensation for work as a judge or clerk of an election.

This resolution shall take effect upon publication one (1) time in the Yates Center News.
